Begun and held at the City of Washington on Thursday, the third day of January, two thousand and thirteen

DEFINITIONS

IPV – INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE

EXERTING POWER OR CONTROL OVER A PERSON THAT YOU HAVE OR HAVE PREVIOUSLY HAD A RELATIONSHIP WITH. IPV CAN TAKE MANY FORMS, RANGING FROM PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL, ECONOMIC, OR VERBAL ABUSE.



DEFINITIONS

TRAUMA IS AN EVENT THAT COMBINES FEAR, HORROR, OR TERROR WITH ACTUAL OR PERCEIVED LACK OF CONTROL.



EVERY RELATIONSHIP IS DIFFERENT, BUT THE THINGS THAT UNHEALTHY AND ABUSIVE RELATIONSHIPS HAVE IN COMMON ARE ISSUES OF POWER AND CONTROL. VIOLENT WORDS AND ACTIONS ARE TOOLS AN ABUSIVE PARTNER USES TO GAIN AND MAINTAIN POWER AND CONTROL OVER THEIR PARTNER.



PREVALENCE OF INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE



IN THE U.S., MORE THAN 27% OF WOMEN AND 14% OF MEN HAVE EXPERIENCED SEXUAL VIOLENCE, PHYSICAL VIOLENCE, AND/OR STALKING BY AN INTIMATE PARTNER IN THEIR LIFETIME AND EXPERIENCED AN INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE RELATED IMPACT

FROM 2016 THROUGH 2018 THE NUMBER OF INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE CASES IN THE UNITED STATES INCREASED 42%

AN ABUSER'S ACCESS TO A FIREARM INCREASES THE RISK OF INTIMATE PARTNER FEMICIDE BY 400%.

INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE ACCOUNTS FOR 15% OF ALL VIOLENT CRIME.

INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE IS MOST COMMON AGAINST WOMEN BETWEEN THE AGES OF 18-24.

AN AVERAGE OF **24 PEOPLE PER MINUTE** ARE SURVIVORS OF RAPE, PHYSICAL VIOLENCE OR STALKING BY AN INTIMATE PARTNER IN THE UNITED STATES — MORE THAN 12 MILLION WOMEN AND MEN OVER THE COURSE OF A SINGLE YEAR.

WOMEN BETWEEN THE AGES OF 18-24 ARE AT RISK OF SEXUAL ASSAULT AT A RATE THREE TIMES HIGHER THAN OTHER WOMEN.

SEXUAL VIOLENCE IS THE MOST UNDERREPORTED CRIME.





OVER 90% OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE IN THE U.S. GOES UNREPORTED.

LESS THAN 20% OF FEMALE SURVIVORS THAT REPORT THEIR ASSAULT, CHOSE TO REPORT TO THE POLICE.

UNHEALTHY

- CONTROLLING AND JEALOUS
- DISRESPECTFUL OF BOUNDARIES
- ISOLATING FROM FRIENDS & FAMILY
- HUMILIATING AND MANIPULATIVE

ACTIVITY







ALEX AND JORDAN HAVE BEEN DATING FOR TWO YEARS. ALEX MOVES INTO JORDAN'S APARTMENT FOR THEIR JUNIOR YEAR OF COLLEGE.

JORDAN EXPRESSES THAT THEY DON'T LIKE ALEX GOING OUT ON THE WEEKENDS WITH THEIR FRIENDS AND THAT THEY NEED ALEX'S LOCATION CONSTANTLY TURNED ON.

ALEX DOES NOT FEEL COMFORTABLE WITH THIS, BUT JORDAN THREATENS TO THROW ALEX OUT IF THEY DON'T DO IT.

JORDAN STARTS TO TELL ALEX THAT THEIR FRIENDS AND FAMILY **DO NOT TRULY CARE** FOR THEM AND ALEX BEGINS TO GO HOME LESS OFTEN BECAUSE OF THIS

PROTECTION FOR THOSE EXPERIENCING ABUSE



NEUROSCIENCE SUGGESTS THAT MANY COMMON SURVIVOR RESPONSES ARE THE RESULT OF FEAR AND TRAUMA, NOT DECEPTION.



PHYSICAL ABUSE OR THREAT OF PHYSICAL LIFE-THREATENING ABUSE BY AN INTIMATE PARTNER IS A FEDERAL CRIME IN THE UNITED STATES.



FEDERAL LAWS AIMED AT PROTECTING STUDENTS WHO EXPERIENCE IPV AND OTHER FORMS OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE OR GENDER DISCRIMINATION

THESE LAWS CAN HELP YOU ACCURATELY KNOW HOW TO SEEK OR OFFER HELP



TITLE IX

- TITLE IX OF THE EDUCATION AMENDMENTS OF 1972 IS A FEDERAL LAW THAT PROHIBITS DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF SEX IN FEDERALLY FUNDED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.
- TITLE IX DECLARES THAT SEXUAL HARASSMENT AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE ARE PROHIBITED FORMS OF GENDER DISCRIMINATION.
- SEX DISCRIMINATION CAN INCLUDE SEXUAL HARASSMENT OR SEXUAL VIOLENCE, SUCH AS RAPE, SEXUAL ASSAULT, SEXUAL BATTERY, AND SEXUAL COERCION.



TITLE IX

"NO PERSON IN THE UNITED STATES SHALL, ON THE BASIS OF SEX, BE EXCLUDED FROM PARTICIPATION IN, BE DENIED THE BENEFITS OF, OR BE SUBJECTED TO DISCRIMINATION UNDER ANY EDUCATION PROGRAM OR ACTIVITY RECEIVING FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE."



VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN ACT*

THE VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN ACT (VAWA) IS A FEDERAL LAW THAT SUPPORTS RESPONSE TO CRIMES OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, SEXUAL ASSAULT, DATING VIOLENCE AND STALKING. IT WAS SIGNED INTO LAW IN 1994 AND HAS BEEN REAUTHORIZED IN 2000, 2005, AND 2013.

*IT IS UP FOR REAUTHORIZATION AS OF MARCH 2021






CLERY ACT

THE JEANNE CLERY DISCLOSURE OF CAMPUS SECURITY POLICY AND CAMPUS CRIME STATISTICS ACT IS A FEDERAL STATUTE REQUIRING COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES PARTICIPATING IN FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID PROGRAMS TO MAINTAIN AND DISCLOSE CAMPUS CRIME STATISTICS AND SECURITY INFORMATION.

THE VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN REAUTHORIZATION ACT AMENDED THE JEANNE CLERY ACT TO AFFORD ADDITIONAL RIGHTS TO CAMPUS SURVIVORS OF SEXUAL ASSAULT, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE, AND STALKING.





THE IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE



IPV REPORTING RATES DECREASED DURING THE PANDEMIC.









IN SOME REGIONS OF THE COUNTRY, THE NUMBER OF INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE **REPORTED DROPPED** BY MORE THAN 50% BY MARCH 2020.

ONE CALLER TO A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE HOTLINE REPORTED THAT HER HUSBAND THREATENED TO THROW HER OUT INTO THE STREET IF SHE COUGHED.

A CALLER REPORTED THEY HAD BEEN STRANGLED BY THEIR PARTNER BUT FEARED GOING TO THE HOSPITAL BECAUSE OF THE THREAT OF CORONAVIRUS.

AN IMMUNOCOMPROMISED MAN FROM PENNSYLVANIA CALLED IN AFTER HIS EMOTIONALLY ABUSIVE GIRLFRIEND BEGAN HIDING CLEANING SUPPLIES AND HAND SANITIZER FROM HIM.

IF WE KNOW THAT A DECREASE IN REPORTING RATES DOES NOT EQUAL A DECREASE IN PREVALENCE, WHAT IS CAUSING SURVIVORS TO SEEK LESS SERVICES?

AS COVID-19 CASES SURGED IN THE COUNTRY IN MARCH 2020, STAY-AT-HOME ORDERS WERE PUT IN PLACE AND PERSONAL MOVEMENT BECAME LIMITED...





STAY-AT-HOME ORDERS AND ORDERS TO SELF-QUARANTINE, INTENDED TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC AND PREVENT WIDESPREAD INFECTION, LEFT MANY IPV SURVIVORS TRAPPED WITH THEIR ABUSERS

SCHOOLS CLOSED, AND MANY WORKERS WERE FURLOUGHED, LAID OFF, OR TOLD TO WORK FROM HOME CAUSING AN INCREASE IN THE TIME SPENT AT HOME AND WITH THAT, THE POSSIBILITY FOR INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE

SURVIVORS WERE UNABLE TO FIND A WAY TO CONNECT BOTH SAFELY AND PRIVATELY WITH SUPPORT SERVICES
